(Any full-time or part-time educator) that has worked for a congregation, school, or ministry of the English District during the current school year. Includes principals, preschool and childcare directors, and Directors of Christian Education as well as all teachers.

Congregational Volunteer Educator:

Any English District church member that has voluntarily taken on responsibility for teaching or administration on behalf of one of his or her congregation's programs of Christian education during the past year.
